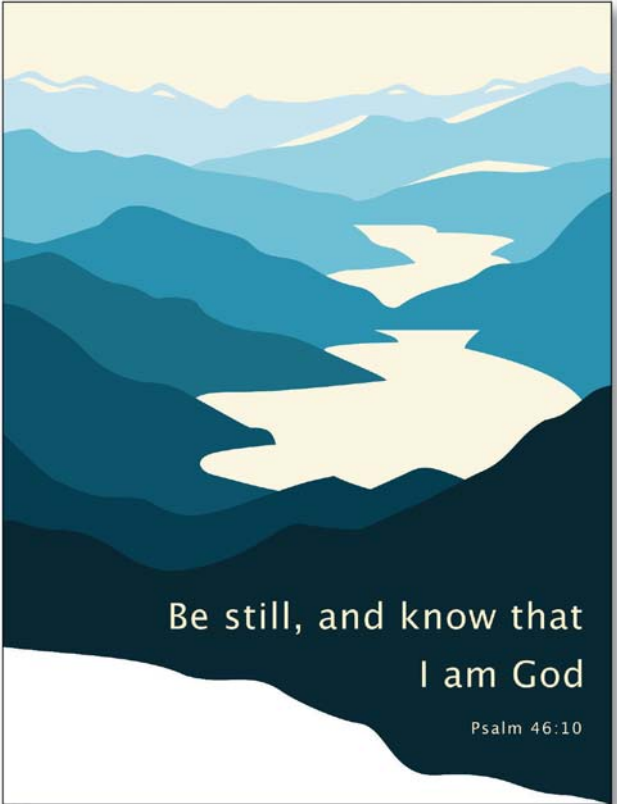

# General Information

The motto *"Be still, and know that I am God"* (Ps. 46:10) is depicted in the chosen logo which illustrates God's creation in the beautiful Pacific Northwest setting for these festive services. More importantly, the motto brings comfort knowing that God cares for His own in the restless time we live. We pray for God's blessings and trust that He will bless us with His Word.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

An Information Booth is located in the hallway near the west entrance. Please contact the Information Booth if you have needs or if you require assistance locating a missing child. Complimentary ID wristbands are available for children at the Information Booth. We ask that all service guests contribute to the cleanliness of the service site by disposing of garbage correctly and recycling all cans and bottles.

Signs and placards will direct you throughout the service site. Please be aware and use caution when walking through the parking lots, and when walking alongside and crossing nearby roads. Please cross Cathcart Way only at the stoplight crosswalk when walking to or from Willis Tucker Park.

The service site, grounds, and parking lots open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 11:00 p.m., except on Saturday night when closing is 12:00 a.m.

## **COLLECTIONS**

Collectors are wearing green armbands during collection times noted in the schedule. Please make checks payable to "LLC Summer Services". Service donations may also be made through the LLC website, using the "Make a Charitable Donation" form or via credit card at the Meal Ticket Booth or Publication Sales Booth.

## **COMMUNION**

The communion service is at 6:00 p.m. Saturday evening .

Communion guests please note the following:

- Ushers are positioned throughout the service area to direct the Communion lines.
- Please remain seated until ushers release your section of seating.
- Those seated outside will be ushered in after the Main Service Area has been served.
- The Communion line enters from the two interior side aisles and will exit through the center and exterior side aisles.
- The front rows are reserved for those who are unable to wait in line and will be served Communion at their seats.
- Communion will also be served in the Elder's Room for elders who wish to be served there.
- Gluten-free wafers will be available on a stand as you approach the Communion rail.

## **ELDERS ROOM**

The Elder's Room is located off the hallway near the north entrance. Elders may enjoy their meals there. Communion will be available to elders who wish to be served in the Elder's Room.

## **FIRST AID**

The First Aid Station is located off the hallway near the north entrance. The station will be staffed by qualified medical personnel one hour prior to the start of services until 10:00 p.m. each day and has information regarding nearby walk-in clinics and area hospitals. *In the case of an emergency, please dial 911. The service site address is 7401 144th Pl SE, Snohomish, WA 98296*

**PLEASE NOTE:** No food or beverages other than water are allowed in the Main Service Area.

### **FOOD SERVICE**

Meal tickets are available for sale near the Information Booth and from salespersons near the Concessions Stand and HAC Booth. Ticket prices are \$7.00 per individual or \$30.00 per family (including children 15 years and younger).

Meals will be served in the cafeteria and at the outdoor grill area. If desired, elders may enjoy their meals in the Elder's Room. Meal options are as follows:

**Outdoor grill:** Serving from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

- Hamburgers
- Hot dogs
- Salads

**Dining area:** Serving from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

- **Available every meal:** Domino's pizza; variety of entrée salads
- **Friday & Saturday lunch:** Chicken tortilla soup
- **Saturday lunch:** Ivar's clam chowder
- **Friday & Saturday supper:** Oven-roasted vegetable and sausage medley

Coffee will be available throughout the services, for a donation.

### **GROUP PICTURES**

All ministers serving at our services and guests from overseas should meet at the Festive Service Gate near the west entrance at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 7 for group pictures.

### **LLC HUMANITARIAN AID DISPLAY**

The LLC Humanitarian Aid Committee (HAC) display is located between the Commons and the Courtyard. Please visit the display to learn more about this work and how you can help the believers in Ecuador, Ghana, and Togo. Information regarding the West Africa church facilities fund will also be available. Donations can be made at the HAC Booth.

### **LODGING**

Area lodging information is available on the LLC website. Payment and registration for RV overnight parking or tenting should be made online, prior to arriving services. RV and tenting sites are assigned on a first come, first served basis. Assistants will be ready to help you get into your spot at Willis Tucker Park or at GPHS. For additional lodging assistance, please contact the Information Booth.

### **LOST AND FOUND**

The Lost and Found is at the Information Booth. Found items will also be posted on the Summer Services Facebook page during services.

### **MOTHERS ROOM**

A Mothers Room is located off the hallway near the north entrance.

### **PARKING**

Carpooling is recommended. Parking attendants are available to help with parking. There are two easy drop-off zones for elders and those needing assistance near the south and west entrances. The parking spaces nearest the school entrances will also be reserved for elders and those needing assistance. Please drive slowly, as the area is very close to high pedestrian traffic. Over-flow parking will be available at Willis Tucker Park, with shuttle service to the service site.

### **PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION**

Prayer requests can be placed in the Prayers of Intercession box at the Information Booth.

## **SALES**

Sales booths are open throughout the services except during the Communion Service.

A selection of LLC and SRK publications are available for purchase at the Publication Sales Booth located between the Commons and the Courtyard.

A Concessions Stand is located between the Commons and Main Service Area. Two Specialty Coffee Stands are located in the Commons. Cash or credit card may be used. A Sweet Treat Card (a prepaid non-refundable punch card in \$5, \$10, or \$20 amounts) can be used to purchase blended coffee drinks and concessions items. The cards can be purchased at all Meal Ticket Sales locations.

Items available for Silent Auction will be displayed near the Information Booth. Bids for each item can be submitted at the Information Booth. A winner of a Silent Auction item will be notified directly, and must pick up the item before the end of services.

Bags of Summer Services coffee will be sold at the two Specialty Coffee Stands in the Commons.

## **SHUTTLE SERVICE**

Shuttle service between Glacier Peak High School and Willis Tucker Park will be running during the following times:

- **Thursday, July 5:** 4:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.
- **Friday and Saturday, July 6 and 7:** 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.
- **Sunday, July 8:** 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

Designated shuttle pick-up/drop-off locations are clearly marked.

## **SPECIAL NEEDS AND TRANSLATION**

Guests with special needs may request assistance at the Information Booth or proceed directly to the Special Needs Room, which is located off the hallway near the north entrance. Headsets for both hearing assistance and translation of services into Finnish are also available at the Sound Booth to the left of the entrance inside the Main Service Area. Devices can be checked out before services and should be returned after each session of services.

## **TOBACCO USE**

Tobacco use is limited to our designated smoking area located at the end of the public street 144 Pl SE, outside of the south entrance. In accordance with state laws, no other locations are authorized for tobacco use. Please dispose of cigarettes in the cans provided at the smoking area.

## **YOUTH ACTIVITIES**

The service site, grounds, and parking lots close at 11:00 p.m., with the exception of 12:00 a.m. on Saturday night.

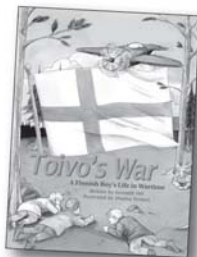
